

In August of 2005, the European Union (EU) implemented the EU WEEE Directive 2002/96/EC and later the WEEE Recast Directive 2012/19/EU requiring Producers of electronic and electrical equipment (EEE) to manage the collection, reuse, recycling and to appropriately treat WEEE that the Producer places on the EU market after August 13, 2005. The goal of this directive is to minimize the volume of electrical and electronic waste disposal and to encourage re-use and recycling at the end of life.

Rhopoint Instruments/Hanatek Ltd has elected to join a WEEE Compliance Scheme to help manage customer returns at end-of-life. If you have purchased a Rhopoint Instruments/Hanatek Ltd branded electrical or electronic product in the EU and are intending to discard these products at the end of their useful life, please do not dispose of them with your other household or municipal waste.
